Summer Care Basics

- Space will be limited to 30 campers per week (first come, first served).
- Application, Family Profile, Medication Authorization, Field Trip Permission Form, and Payment is due by Friday, April 26th.
 - Full-time care from 7:30 AM till 5:30 PM

June 17th-21st-VBS from 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM and camp from 12:00 PM till 5:30PM

- Open to SJN students and church members who are five (5) years old by May 1st, 2024 up to rising 8th grade.
 - Adventure themed weeks.

Things to Know

- The Tennessee Department of Education requires a parent/guardian to drop off/sign in and pick up/sign out each day.
- Campers MUST be picked up/signed out prior to 5:30 PM each day. You will be charged a late fee of \$10 for every 15 minutes you are late.
- We will NOT be providing lunch. A lunch and additional snacks must be packed from home. We will be providing a snack at 3:00 PM each day.
 - Every child will have a chance to participate in indoor and outdoor activities.
 - Each week we will have different themes centered on arts and crafts,
 - cooking, and games.
- Students will also be allowed free time and will have 30 minutes of quiet time after lunch. During this time students may rest, read or go to the library.

Things to Remember or Bring

- Sunscreen (children must be able to apply their own or come with it already on)
 - Backpack or gym bag
 - Towel on water days
 - Socks (required for inflatables)
 - An extra change of clothes
- Electronic devices can be used from 7:30 AM 8:30 AM and 4:00 5:30 PM. This
 privilege may be taken away if the director feels it's necessary. The child is
 responsible for his/hers device if lost or stolen.

2024 Mustang Summer Camp Guidelines

Morning Drop-Off

- Drop off/check-in will occur at the side door of the cafeteria.
 - Each child will need to be signed in by a staff member.

Pick-Up

- Parent must park and walk to cafeteria side door.
- You will need to sign your child out with time and signature.
 - Please bring identification with you.

Daily Care Procedures/Expectations

- We will not have access to a microwave, so don't pack anything that needs to be heated.
 - A packed snack is encouraged, but one will be given at 3:00 PM each day.
 - We will have the children wash their hands regularly and we will have sanitizer available throughout each location in the building.
 - Toys will be sanitized at the end of each day.
 - Children can bring toys from home, but they will be the ones responsible for it.
 - If a child is to get sick during the day, that child will be isolated from the others until
 they are picked up.
 - A parent must pick up their sick child within an hour of the camp directors phone call.
